Volunteer Position Announcement

The Village Bicycle Project is seeking a short-term volunteer (3-6 months) to develop and implement a bicycle repair course for women in Ghana.

We are working with a female bicycle repairer who has identified several women in her community who are interested in receiving training in bicycle repair. She will need support in developing the curriculum and also in developing her teaching skills. The objective would be to train several female bicycle mechanics, build instructor capacity and develop a program that could be repeated with other groups of women. VBP will support the volunteer with materials (bicycles, parts, tools), transportation, communication and housing costs within Ghana.

A limited, negotiable stipend may be available upon completion of measurable outcomes. Outcomes include the successful completion of the training program and consistent, professional reporting on daily class activities, successes, and challenges.
